Highlights include Pegasus Bridge, the first ground in France liberated on D-Day by British paratroopers, and Sainte-Mère-Église, where American paratroopers famously descended into battle. At the D-Day landing beaches—including Utah Beach and Omaha Beach—expert guides will share stories of valor and sacrifice, with a poignant visit to the Normandy American Cemetery, the resting place of more than 9,000 American servicemen and women. We will also explore strategic wartime sites such as Longues-sur-Mer Battery, a key component of the Atlantic Wall, and the remarkable Mulberry Harbors, an engineering marvel that enabled the successful staging of the invasion.

Beyond the battlefields, enjoy a scenic excursion to Mont Saint-Michel, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and Château de Tocqueville, the family home of the famous French philosopher Alexis de Tocqueville. Optional pre- and post-tour extensions to Paris and the Loire Valley are available for those wishing to explore France further.

Space is limited for this special commemorative tour. Reserve your spot today to embark on a journey of reflection, remembrance, and inspiration. Whether you're a history enthusiast, a veteran, a descendant, or a curious traveler, this tour offers a unique opportunity to honor the past, understand the present, and walk in the footsteps of heroes. SEE the remains of the Mulberry Harbors, the ingenious temporary ports that made the massive Allied landings possible and stand as a testament to wartime innovation.

Itinerary

DAY 1: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2026

U.S. / Paris, France

Depart the U.S. on an overnight flight to Paris, France. (MEALS ALOFT)

DAY 2: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11

Paris

Arrive in Paris and transfer to our hotel. This evening, gather for a welcome cocktail and orientation.

DAY 3: MONDAY, OCTOBER 12

Pegasus Bridge / Bayeux / Caen

Today, we head to Normandy, starting with a visit to the iconic Pegasus Bridge. Captured by British paratroopers, this strategic crossing became the first ground liberated in France and was crucial in securing the eastern flank of the Allied

DAY 4: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 13

Sainte-Mère-Église / Tocqueville / Utah Beach

At the heart of the Airborne operation, we'll visit the historic town of Sainte-Mère-Église, the first to be liberated by American paratroopers. Here, you'll learn the dramatic story of the night drop that changed history—including the famous moment when a paratrooper's chute snagged on the church steeple, leaving him suspended for two hours. Our visit includes time to explore the excellent Airborne Museum, which honors the men of the U.S. Army's 82nd and 101st Airborne Divisions. We'll then continue to Tocqueville for a guided tour of the former home of Alexis de Tocqueville, the celebrated French political philosopher. Finally, we'll head to Utah Beach, the westernmost Allied landing site, where the U.S. 4th Infantry Division broke through German defenses. The museum here is built atop a German bunker and features compelling exhibits on the landing, including an original B-26 bomber and moving personal artifacts. invasion. After lunch at a local restaurant, we move on to Bayeux for a guided walking tour and a visit to the Memorial Museum of the Battle of Normandy which shows the full scope of military operations carried out across Norman soil during the summer of 1944. DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14

Mont Saint-Michel

We will spend the day at Mont Saint-Michel, a medieval village perched on

a rock in the middle of a bay shared by Normandy and Brittany, with constantly shifting tides that give it a mythical dimension. Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the history of the abbey dates back to 708. It is peppered with anecdotes and legends from centuries, inspiring artists and pilgrims along the way. Occupied by German forces during WWII, it was used as both a tourist attraction and observation point for German soldiers. It was famously liberated by a single American soldier accompanied by two British reporters. Following lunch on your own, we'll return to Caen for the remainder of the day at leisure.

DAY 6: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 15

Pointe Du Hoc / Omaha Beach / Arromanches

Today we'll visit the historic site of Pointe du Hoc, where the 2nd U.S. Ranger Battalion scaled dramatic cliffs while under heavy fire to destroy a German gun battery threatening the whole U.S. landing operation. Bomb craters, bunkers, and dugouts remain visible today. Continue to nearby Omaha Beach, where the 1st and 29th





Infantry Divisions landed. Infamous for the fierce fighting and high casualties experienced by American troops on D-Day, we will learn about the plight of the first waves and hear stories of the brave GIs who eventually secured the area, paving the way for the liberation of Western Europe. Just behind Omaha Beach is the Normandy American Cemetery, the final resting place of more than 9,000 American servicemen and women. This sacred place, run by the American Battle Monuments Commission, is the most visited D-Day site in Normandy. We will also visit the Longues-sur-Mer German artillery battery, a critical component of the Atlantic Wall. Perched on cliffs overlooking the English Channel, its command post and four casemates—each still containing its original 150mm gun—testify to its strategic importance on D-Day. Our full-day tour ends in Arromanches at the site of the Mulberry Harbors. This remarkable engineering feat enabled the Allies to build artificial ports within days of the landings, providing a safe staging area for men and supplies that fueled the campaign across France. DAY 7: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 16

Caen Memorial / Paris

The Caen Memorial Museum offers an essential journey through the Battle of Normandy and the defining events of the 20th century. Our visit traces the story of World War II, from the rise of fascism and the tragedy of the Holocaust to the Normandy Landings and the hard-fought peace that followed. Immersive exhibits and impactful films vividly bring these moments to life. At the same time, additional galleries examine the Cold War and host thought-provoking temporary exhibitions. After lunch at the museum, we continue to Paris, pausing in the charming village of Giverny. There, we will visit the former home of Claude Monet and stroll through the beautiful gardens that inspired many of his masterpieces, including the celebrated waterlilies. This evening, we gather for a farewell dinner. VICTORIA PALACE HOTEL OR SIMILAR (B, L, D)

DAY 8: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17

Flights To U.S.

Please note that the order of activities on the itinerary may change due to local conditions. Alterations in the schedule may occur to allocate time to enjoy visits and to take advantage of unexpected opportunities.

Paris, October 8-11

Arrive a few days early to explore the City of Lights, including a visit to the Notre Dame Cathedral, finishing its multi-year restoration following a fire in

April 2019. We will also have the opportunity to explore the complex at Les Invalides, originally commissioned in the 17th century by Louis XIV to provide accommodations and hospital care for wounded soldiers. Today, a military hospital still operates there, in addition to multiple museums exhibiting military history throughout the years. We will take time exploring the Musée de la Libération, a World War II history museum dedicated to the liberation of the city and the French Resistance, and see the famous large-scale Waterlilies at l'Orangerie, first offered to the French State by the painter Claude Monet on the day that followed the Armistice of November 11, 1918 as a symbol for peace. The pre-tour extension includes group airport transfer, two nights at the Victoria Palace Hotel in Paris, two breakfasts, two lunches, entrance fees, a private motorcoach, and an English-speaking guide. The extension price is based on a minimum of 10 participants.



OPTIONAL **POST-TRIP** EXTENSION:

Loire Valley, October 17-19

Extend your trip to explore the enchanting Loire Valley with a journey through its most iconic châteaux and charming towns. Travel to Chambord for a guided visit of the magnificent Château de Chambord before continuing to Amboise. Visits in Amboise include the Château Gaillard and Leonardo da Vinci's last residence, the Manoir du Clos Lucé, followed by an afternoon tour of the fairytale Château de Chenonceau. The post-tour extension includes two nights at the Hotel Clos d'Amboise or similar, two breakfasts, two lunches, an English-speaking guide, and transfer to Charles de Gaulle airport in Paris. The extension price is based on a minimum of 8 participants.

Victoria Palace Hotel

Established in 1913 and fully renovated in 2020, the hotel features 92 elegantly appointed rooms. Its prime location provides easy access to cultural landmarks, shopping districts, and public transportation. The hotel also boasts a full-service spa, 24-hour fitness center, and a cozy bar/lounge. Each room is equipped with air conditioning, heating, soundproofing, flat-screen TVs, minibars, and complimentary high-speed Wi-Fi.

Mercure Caen Centre Plaisance

The Mercure Caen Centre Port de Plaisance is a four-star hotel perfectly placed in the heart of Caen and overlooking the marina. Just a few minutes' walk from the pedestrian zone, Château de Caen, and the historic Vaugueux district, the hotel is an ideal base for exploring Caen's rich heritage and the nearby D-Day landing beaches. It offers 126 stylishly refurbished, air-conditioned rooms including complimentary Wi-Fi throughout, a fitness center, bar-lounge, and a bright atrium opening onto garden patios.



What to Expect

This specially curated journey is open to alumni, family, and friends of Saint Anselm College who share an interest in World War II history—particularly D-Day and the Battle of Normandy—along with France’s rich culture, cuisine, and broader history. Together, we’ll explore iconic sites that bring to life the events and experiences of the war and their lasting impact on the world. The tour is moderately active, involving some walking over uneven ground. Typical daytime temperatures in Normandy range from the mid-50s to the low 60s °F, making for comfortable touring, though mornings and evenings can be cooler—ideal for a light jacket or sweater. Since weather in the region can be unpredictable, we suggest bringing an umbrella or light rain jacket. To enjoy this experience fully, bring a spirit of adventure, a willingness to explore historic landscapes, and an openness to discovery. Travel will be by private, comfortable coach, with accommodations in welcoming four-star hotels.
